POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Group Facilitation – with strict adherence to a manualized cognitive behavioural program, assist in the facilitation of weekly group sessions with enrolled boys/girls in summer camps to teach SNAP®.
- Work in collaboration with Child and Family Worker staff to coordinate and implement daily activities for the children during sessions and summer, which includes SNAP learning material and activities.
- Reorganizing terminated client files
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

- Pursing and actively enrolled in a Child and Youth Worker program or related discipline and or/equivalent program.
- Preference will be given to individuals with demonstrated experience in working directly with children and facilitating groups.
- Ability to establish healthy connections with children and utilize behavioural management techniques.
- Strong communication written and oral, and listening skills.
- Demonstrated strong interpersonal, conflict resolution skills, ability to work within a team.
- An acceptable Criminal Reference Check/Vulnerable Sector Screening and Health Assessment at the candidate’s own expense.
- Must be between 18 - 30 years of age.
- Must have been registered as full-time student in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year.
- Must be a Canadian citizen and legally entitled to work in Canada.
