- In accordance to the Statement from [Minister Elliott and Minister Smith on the Social Services Sector's Response to COVID-19](#) non-essential visitors will not be permitted to enter the following Banyan facilities:
 - Arrell Youth Centre (AYC)
 - Peninsula Youth Centre (PYC)
 - George R. Force (GRF)
- All essential visitors, including vendors, will be asked to complete a COVID-19 screening questionnaire... Individuals with responses marked YES will be turned away and recommended to self-quarantine at home for 14 days, as per Public Health mandate.
- Effective March 25, 2020 the office at 688 Queensdale Avenue in Hamilton will be closed to the public until further notice.
