To protect the health and safety of our clients, staff and community, Banyan has implemented the following measures:

- Effective March 16, 2020 SNAP[®] and SURE groups have been temporarily suspended until further notice.
- The Grocer Ease program remains open on a client by client basis... please contact the Program Supervisor for further information.
- The following programs remain available for crisis counselling through telephone support:
 - Counselling and Assessment
 - o Mental Health Youth Court Worker Support
 - o Substance Abuse Counselling and Support
- In accordance to the Statement from <u>Minister Elliott and Minister Smith on the Social Services</u> <u>Sector's Response to COVID-19</u> non-essential visitors will <u>not</u> be permitted to enter the following Banyan facilities:
 - Arrell Youth Centre (AYC)
 - Peninsula Youth Centre (PYC)
 - George R. Force (GRF)
- All essential visitors, including vendors, will be asked to complete a COVID-19 screening questionnaire. Individuals with responses marked YES will be turned away and recommended to self-quarantine at home for 14 days, as per Public Health mandate.
- Effective March 25, 2020 the office at 688 Queensdale Avenue in Hamilton will be closed to the public until further notice.
